FINIDIP 1406

Bright Cr³ Blue Passivation For Pure Zinc

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1. Product description

General

Finidip 1406 is a liquid passivate, designed to give a Bright blue finish and high corrosion resistance. This is totally hexavalent chromium free formulation designed to combine high corrosion resistance with a décorative blue appearance with minimum 8 microns of Zinc thickness. Shade variation is minimum when controlled parameters are maintained. This can be applied to alkaline non-cyanide zinc as well as Acid zinc processes for both Rack and Barrel applications. Where very high corrosion resistance is required, the action of Finidip 1406 may be enhanced by the application of Finigard Series material over the passivate film.

- Can be applied as blue and thick film passivate
- High corrosion protection with/without heat treatment
- For rack and barrel applications
- For acid and alkaline zinc
- Easy wastewater treatment

2. Make up and maintenance

Make up

Chemicals for 100 L passivate solution

Additives	Blue Passivate
FINIDP 1406	8 ltr

Make-up procedure

- 1. Add 2/3 of the required water to the operating tank. DI water is recommended.
- 2. With constant agitation, add the required amount of FINIDP 1406.
- 3. Fill to the final operating level with water.
- 4. Adjust the pH to 2.0 with nitric acid or caustic soda.
- 5. Confirm the temperature of the bath is within the correct range. Adjust if necessary.
- 6. The FINIDP 1406 solution is now ready for use.

For control of pH use nitric acid (65%) or sodium hydroxide (30%). For make-up and maintenance of the passivation no circulation water from ion exchangers should be used since the water may contain surfactants or other impurities

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Equipment

Tank and related equipment

PVC, polyethylene, polypropylene, or rubber lined steel tanks are suitable for use with **FINIDP 1406** solutions.

Bath agitation and air injection

A good and uniform air agitation is necessary for a constant colour and optimal brightness.

Heating

A heater is necessary to maintain the temperature during winter time. Ceramic bath heater, spirals or heating elements made of Teflon, PVDF or plastic coated steel can be used. It is not necessarily required to work with an automatic temperature control.

Analytical control

pH-value

The pH value should be checked regularly. The pH is adjusted with a 30% sodium hydroxide solution or nitric acid (65%).

Replenishment and maintenance

The passivation **FINIDP 1406** can be controlled easily by aspect of the passivated parts and the pH. The passivation, however, should be replenished continuously using the consumption rates. A too strong drop of the passivation concentration has to be avoided. In such cases the full performance of the passivation often cannot be regained. This is especially observed in older passivation.

3. Waste water treatment

General

Operating solutions of **FINIDP 1406** do NOT contain hexavalent chromium. They will, however, contain heavy metals, namely trivalent chromium, zinc and iron that may need to be treated based upon the combined overall wastewater flow and the existing treatment process.
